What is different between the two programs?



All students in the class are identified gifted and have an EP (education plan)



Minimum of 3 of their 4 core teachers will have a gifted endorsement.



Students attend the school that offers center for gifted studies and students build relationships with like-minded peers who learn like them daily.



Some students in the class are identified as gifted learners and the rest of the class is made up of high-achieving.



Minimum of 2 of their 4 core teachers will have a gifted endorsement.



Students have the opportunity to attend Skybrooke K8 to receive enriched curriculum throughout the week with both gifted and high achieving peers.

Examples of what is the same at Skybrooke K8 vs Center for Gifted Studies

- Specialized instruction through differentiation.
 - Instruction is given using Pasco County Schools approved core curriculum resources and instruction covers the grade level standards outlined by the State of Florida.
- Both settings offer accelerated, honors or enriched classes.
 - Gifted services are offered for eligible students in grades 3-8.
- Both settings offer Critical Thinking and Problem Solving activities and projects.
